use their iPads to create a digital poster. All posters have


been uploaded to each students' SeeSaw page.

Camp Program



At Irymple South we offer a structured camp program. The program is intended to give the students a broad range of experiences on which to build knowledge about our own local area and the greater area in proximity to Mildura. We aim to provide a sequential program that provides students with the opportunities to develop independence and resilience. The School Camp program, which occurs for all year levels in Term 4, is not included in the Parent Payment. All costs will be kept to a minimum and may change.

Grade 5 and 6

The students will be going to Roses Gap, in the Grampians, this year on their camp. They will leave on **Wednesday 13th November and return on Friday 15th November**. The cost of this camp is \$400.

Grade 4 Camp

The students will be attending Lake Cullulleraine Camp from **Wednesday 11th to Friday 13th December**. The total cost for the camp will be \$195.


