My name is Shantelle Thompson and I am strong and proud Barkindji, Ngiyampaa and European woman of descent. I am the new Koori Engagement Support Officer for your school for Term 4 2020 & Term 1 2021, while Simone is on maternity leave. She will be back in Term 2 to work with your school, students, families and community. I grew up in Dareton until I was 16 and then Mildura from 17 onwards. This area is my home and community. For the last x7 years I have been living in Melbourne with my family, while pursuing my Martial Arts career in Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu and Free-style wrestling. During this time I have worked in many different roles, travelled the world competing, and starting two businesses. I have always had a strong passion for my culture, community, our young people and education. I am now excited and proud to bring my lived, learned and earned experiences, knowledge and skills to this role and home to the community.

I am grateful to have the opportunity to serve our community, young people and families in this role. Below is a little more information about me. And I have also provided a link to a youtube video that shares more of my story and background for those interested in knowing more.

Shantelle is a proud Barkindji/European Woman, proud mother of x3 children including twins. After being diagnosed with crippling postnatal depression, 33-year-old Barkindji woman Shantelle Thompson took up Brazilian jiu-jitsu to help her heal. Little did she know that a world title and an Olympics wrestling bid would form a part of the healing process. From this beginning Shantelle has gone on to win x3 World Titles in Jiu-Jitsu all in her 30's, made a bid for 2016 Rio Olympics in freestyle wrestling, was selected as an ambassador for the GC2018 Commonwealth Games and made it onto the Australian Wrestling Shadow Team for the GC2018 Games. All this whilst managing a family of x3, working, earning a double degree in teaching/arts, post-graduate certificate of Indigenous Trauma and Recovery and starting her own business. Shantelle is a strong advocate for equality, human rights and fighting for what is right. She uses her lived, earned and learning life journey experiences to inspire and empower others. Shantelle is a powerful, strong and passionate woman who is open and shares her story willingly to empower others.
