I hope that you enjoyed the Learning Conferences that were held on Monday. There was lots of excited talk about the learning that has been happening and how each child is progressing.




Camp Program



We are excited to offer a camp program in Term 4 this year. The program is intended to give the students a broad range of experiences on which to build knowledge about our own local area and the greater area in proximity to Mildura. We aim to provide a sequential program that provides students with the opportunities to develop independence and resilience. School Council will be subsidising the cost of the Prep to Grade 4 camps, to keep costs to a minimum. The listed cost is the 'set price' for the camp and School Council will fund the rest of the cost.

Grade 5 and 6

The students will be going to Ballarat, this year on their camp. They will leave on Wednesday 19th October and return on Friday 21st October. The cost of this camp is \$150. This camp is being subsidised by the 'Positive Start Initiative'.

Grade 4 Camp

The Grade 4 students will be travelling to Broken Hill. The camp will be from Wednesday 5th October to Friday 7th October. The cost of the camp is \$150.

Grade 3 Camp

The students will be attending Lake Cullulleraine Camp from Thursday 13th to Friday 14th December. The cost for the camp will be \$100.

Grade 2 Excursion and Sleepover

Grade 2 students will be sleeping over at school on a Thursday night. They will participate in a variety of out of school activities during the day on the Friday (dates to be confirmed) The cost of the excursion and sleepover is \$50.

Grade 1 Excursion and Dinner

Grade 1 students will be participating in their end of year excursion and dinner at school (date to be confirmed). The cost will be \$30.

Prep Excursion and Dinner

Prep students will be participating in their excursion and dinner at school (date to be confirmed). The cost of this will be \$20.
