Japanese Encephalitis

Help us help your town

The Victorian Department of Health is conducting a study in this area to understand more about the risk of Japanese Encephalitis.

Why?

Japanese encephalitis is a rare but potentially serious mosquito-borne disease.

By providing blood for this study, you will help us understand how many people have been infected with the virus. This will help us plan our vaccination and other prevention activities.

What's involved?

To participate, you will need to:

- Complete a short questionnaire
- Give a small blood sample – if you are already getting blood taken for another reason this will not require an extra needle

You will be informed of your individual test results.

Who can be involved?

Participants must not have been:

1. Previously vaccinated for Japanese Encephalitis
2. Previously diagnosed with Japanese Encephalitis
3. Born in one of the following countries: Bangladesh, Brunei, Burma, Cambodia, China, Guam, India, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, Nepal, North Korea, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Russia, Saipan, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, Timor-Leste or Vietnam

All ages are welcome, however children aged under 18 years must be accompanied (and have consent provided) by a parent or guardian.

How do I take part?

This study is being conducted through your local pathology providers.

You will be provided with a study information sheet. If you are happy to participate, please complete the consent form and questionnaire. Once these are completed, a staff member will give you a pathology slip for the study and you can have your sample collected.
