

BYOD

At Irymple South Primary School we are striving to support and prepare our student for the world in which they live.



BYOD PORTAL

At Irymple South we have implemented a 1:1 learning program where each student will have access to a digital device to complete learning tasks. The preferred model at Irymple South is based on Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) where students bring their own iPads which are either purchased or leased directly by families.

This year, ISPS has partnered with JB Hi-Fi Education Solutions and Learning with Technologies to provide iPad purchasing options. Both BYOD portals can be accessed on our website <u>https://irymplesouthps.vic.edu.au/byod/</u>
