## Year 6 Swimming and Water Safety Program

The Swimming in Schools initiative provides funding to contribute to the cost of delivering quality swimming and water safety education so all students have the opportunity to:

learn how to swim
develop lifelong skills in water safety to reduce their risk of drowning and injury

By the end of primary school, it is anticipated that students should be able to demonstrate the knowledge and skills identified in the Victorian Water Safety Certificate. The Certificate is awarded when a student can:

•swim 50m continuously

- •perform a survival sequence wearing light clothing
- •answer water safety-based questions
- •perform non-swimming rescue techniques
- •respond to an emergency by demonstrating DRSAB and recovery position.



In response to this program Irymple South Primary School are running an intensive program targeted at all Year 3 to year 6 students delivered by qualified swimming instructors at the Mildura Waves Aquatic Centre.

The Year 6 students intensive program will run from Monday 5th May to Friday 9th May. A permission note has been sent out via XUNO.
