Year 5 Intensive Swimming and Water Safety Program

This week, the Year 5 students have participated in a Swimming and Water Safety Program at the Mildura Wave Pool. The students have been working on developing their swimming strokes. They have also been learning important skills for survival in the water such as survival strokes, floating and sculling, what to do if they do get in trouble in the water, how to rescue someone while keeping themselves safe and how to assess and look after an unconscious person. Even though, they are very tired they have had a blast swimming every day!

















Year 3 Swimming and Water Safety Program

The Swimming in Schools initiative provides funding to contribute to the cost of delivering quality swimming and water safety education so all students have the opportunity to:

- •learn how to swim
- •develop lifelong skills in water safety to reduce their risk of drowning and injury

By the end of primary school, it is anticipated that students should be able to demonstrate the knowledge and skills identified in the Victorian Water Safety Certificate. The Certificate is awarded when a student can:

- •swim 50m continuously
- perform a survival sequence wearing light clothing
- answer water safety-based questions
- •perform non-swimming rescue techniques
- •respond to an emergency by demonstrating DRSAB and recovery position.



The Year 3 students intensive program will run from Monday 19th May to Friday 23rd May. Permission notes have been sent out on XUNO.
