BUILDING UPDATE

I'd like to provide an important update regarding Rooms 12 and 13 (2M and 2G classrooms). Recently, I received information from the Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA) about the ongoing works to address issues with the relocatable building.

Due to additional structural concerns that have come to light, the VSBA will be conducting more in-depth investigations. As a result, it is now unlikely that the works will be completed within the initially anticipated timeline. I understand that this situation has caused disruption and concern for students, families, and staff, and I want to acknowledge the impact this has had on our school community.

To help ease this disruption, I am currently working closely with a building contractor to establish a temporary learning space in the multi-purpose room. This will enable 2M to transition into their own dedicated classroom next week, without affecting the delivery of our specialist Art program.

I will continue to keep you informed as more details become available and thank you for your continued support, patience, and understanding during this time. I would also like to acknowledge the flexibility and professionalism of our Grade 2 teachers, Specialist Teachers and students.
