Musica Viva Incursion - Rhythm Works

On Tuesday, our students were lucky to experience a visiting performance from Musica Viva called *Rhythm Works*. The musicians introduced us to a wide variety of instruments – some traditional and some created from everyday items found around the house.

Throughout the performance, they played different pieces of music, encouraging us to imagine pictures and stories in our

minds, such as a chameleon, road train, waterfall and carnival. Students explored the elements of music such as rhythm, dynamics, and pitch, while discovering how sound can paint images without words.

There was plenty of audience participation, with students clapping, joining in with body percussion and even playing some of their instruments. The performance was both fun and inspiring, showing us how music can be created and enjoyed in different creative ways.

In line with our Sunsmart policy, all students are to wear hats from the 1 st




September. For the remainder of the term the students will be encouraged to wear their hats. As of the beginning of Term 4 all students must wear their hat.

Camp Program

Our camp program will happen during Term 4, with the Grade 4 trip to Broken Hill being the first one. The program is intended to give the students a broad range of experiences on which to build knowledge about our own local area and the greater area in proximity to Mildura. We aim to provide a sequential program that provides students with the opportunities to develop independence and resilience.



School Council will be subsidising the cost of all camps this year, to keep costs to a minimum. These subsidies are made by using the Mildura College Lands Trust funding that we receive. The listed cost is the 'set price' for the camp and School Council will fund the rest of the cost.

Grade 6 Camp

The students will be going to Roses Gap, this year on their camp. They will leave on Wednesday 29th October and return on Friday 31st October. The cost for this camp will be \$300.

Grade 5 Camp

The students will be going to Ballarat, this year on their camp. They will leave on Wednesday 5th November and return on Friday 7th November. The cost for this camp will be \$300.

Grade 4 Camp

The Grade 4 students will be travelling to Broken Hill. The camp will be from Wednesday 15th October to Friday 17th October. The cost for this camp will be \$300.

Grade 3 Camp

The students will be travelling to Swan Hill. The camp will be from Monday 13th October to Tuesday 14th October. The cost for this camp will be \$250

Grade 2 Excursion and Sleepover

Grade 2 students will be sleeping over at school on Thursday 30th October. They will participate in a variety of out of school activities during the day on the Friday 31st October.

Grade 1 Excursion and Dinner

Grade 1 students will be participating in their end of year excursion and dinner at school on Thursday 13th November. They will finish their day at 6:00pm.

Prep students will be participating in their excursion and dinner at school on Thursday 23rd October. They will finish their day at 6:00pm.
