My favourite part was going to the Wentworth Gaol because we got to see the cells. - Spencer

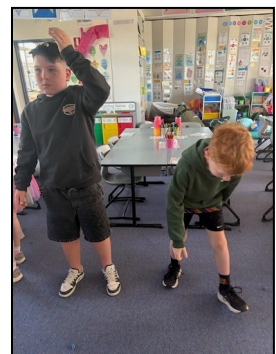
I liked the Perry Sandhills because we climbed the hill all together and we could roll down. - Ella

The disco was fun when I was dancing. - Madison

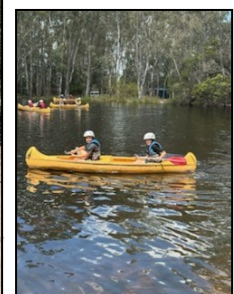
I liked the disco because it was loud and had colourful lights. - Milla
