Prep 2026 Transition

It was wonderful to meet our 2026 Preps on Tuesday. They practised

BYOD

We have witnessed significant changes to Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) programs and use of digital devices in primary schools. Beginning next year, families are not expected to purchase or bring their own iPad to use at school. ISPS will follow the new recommended guidelines provided by the Department of Education, including minimal device time for Prep to Grade 2; and a maximum of 90 minutes per day for Grade 3 to 6.

These changes are intended to support families by reducing cost-of-living pressures. They will also support students by reducing screen-time which can reduce the risk of eye strain, sedentary behaviour, and reduced peer interaction.

Students who already have a device can continue to bring these daily, with the option to leave/store the devices at school overnight.

The students will finish the 2025 school year on Friday 19th December at 1:00pm. Buses will not be running at this time, so you will need to make alternative arrangements.






