Learning Conferences

We will be having 'Learning Conferences' on **Tuesday 24th March**. Students will not attend school on this day, but are expected to attend their conference. Bookings will be via XUNO and we will let you know when they open. 'TheirCare' will offer care during the day if needed.

Absences

If your child is absent, it is a requirement that a parent or guardian informs the school via XUNO, an email to the classroom teacher, message on Seesaw or a phone call. If your child will be absent for an extended period, please inform the class teacher or school before they leave.

Assembly

Each Monday and Friday, whole school assemblies are held. Each week a different class is responsible for running the assembly. The acknowledgement of country is said and the national anthem is sung at Monday's assembly. Birthdays are celebrated on both days. 'Students of the Week' are presented with their certificates on Monday morning.

Attendance

Regular school attendance is vital for your child's progress. All children need to attend school daily. The school teaching program starts promptly at 9:00am, so we suggest that you make sure your child arrives about 20 minutes before this time to get themselves organised and have a chat with their friends. School finishes at 3:15pm, with bus travellers getting on their bus at 3:10pm. Please schedule any non-essential appointments outside these hours. We recommend that students are at school by 8:40am.



Buddies

Each Prep student will have a Grade 6 buddy. Their buddy will help them throughout their first year of school. The Grade 6 students will support their buddy outside in the yard and sometimes help with activities in class. Both the Prep and Grade 6 students love getting to know each other.

Bus

Students can catch a bus to and from school from a variety of locations. If you are considering using the bus to get to school, visit the CDC website

Digital Technologies

Recent changes to the Department's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) policy mean that Primary schools are no longer able to invite parents and carers to supply or purchase a digital device for student use and ownership from 2027. Families who have already purchased devices in previous years for students in Years 1–6 are encouraged to continue sending these devices to school each day, fully charged.

In 2026, our school will continue to use Mosyle School Manager as our device management platform. This enables the secure distribution of educational applications and ensures students access digital resources in a safe and controlled learning environment.

All parents and carers are required to read and accept the [Digital Learning Policy](#) and [Acceptable Use Agreement](#). Students will complete their agreement during class time. Parents and carers must read the policy and complete the agreement via XUNO by **Friday 6 February**.

Communication with the school

We value open lines of communication between home and school. If you have any issues, concerns or queries about your child, please do not hesitate to contact their teacher via XUNO, email or Seesaw. Feel free to pop in and make a time to discuss any matter.

Camps Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF) 2026

The Victorian Government will be providing a CSEF payment to all eligible families to assist with the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. New applicants should contact the office for an application form. If you applied in 2025 and your circumstances have not

changed, you do not need to reapply. Please check with the office and read the flyer further on in the newsletter for more information.

Eating of Snack and Lunch

Snack is eaten in the classroom from 10:50am to 11:00am. Lunch is eaten inside between 1:20pm and 1:30pm.

Extreme Weather

An extreme weather timetable will be enforced when the predicted temperature is 38°C or above. This decision will be made by the Principal or Assistant Principal.

If the day is declared an extreme weather day the following will occur:

- Children will go outside as normal at recess
- Lunches will be eaten inside during the usual class time (1:20pm – 1:30pm)
- Children be able to go outside from 1:30pm – 1:50pm
- Children will have to remain under the shade sails during their time outside
- Children will remain in their classrooms for the remaining 20 minutes
- Children will undertake quiet activities in their classrooms
- Children will be reminded to drink water regularly during the day

Hats

All children are required to wear school bucket hats in the school yard at all times from September 1st through to April 30th. Our school actively supports Sunsmart policies. School hats are available to purchase at Laser Signs and Print.

Healthy Lunch

It is important that children have healthy lunches and snacks at school. We encourage 'rubbish free' lunches to minimise the rubbish in our yard, promote sustainable practices and the waste of resources that are used to wrap food items. By using plastic containers, you can help reduce the amount of rubbish brought to school.

Late Arrivals & Early Departures

Lunchtime Programs

During lunchtime we provide both passive and active activities for all age groups throughout the year. These activities are run by staff and Grade 6 student leaders. Activities occur both inside and outside. The activities change each term and have included board games, Lego, football and netball

Medication

If your child requires medication whilst they are at school, the medication needs to be taken to the office by the parent or guardian. The school can only administer medication if we receive it from an adult. Dosage and times need to be clearly labelled on the medication. Children should not have medication in their bag.

Medical Action Plan

If your child suffers from asthma, anaphylaxis or allergy, we require an action plan that has been filled in and signed by your doctor. This needs to be brought to the school office before the start of the school year. Medical alerts are communicated with all staff and we take these very seriously.

Newsletter

The newsletter is published weekly and distributed electronically on Friday through an email via XUNO. The newsletter provides all the information about our school and it is a vital point of call if you need to know anything. The newsletter is also uploaded to the website and a link posted on Facebook and Instagram.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure

Applications must be submitted to the school by the end of Term 2, 2026
