**Unexpected changes to activities**

In the unlikely event that an activity is unable to run, an alternative activity will be provided. Activities and times are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather or provider availability. If an alternative cannot be provided we will update your review or notify this.

General staff absences are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances at the discretion of the service coordinator.

**Serious stuff!**

**Medical Management Plan & Medication**

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, health-related concerns, medications, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide a completed Medical Management Plan with (include photo)

- necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided. In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication or medication not be supplied.

**Child Care Subsidy**

Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrelink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibility.

**Fortnightly childcare subsidised hours**

Each session is subsidised using the full service operational hours, not the hours attended by the child.

Additional Child Care subsidy will not cover any hours beyond the subsidised hours per fortnight.
