ATHLETICS SPORTS

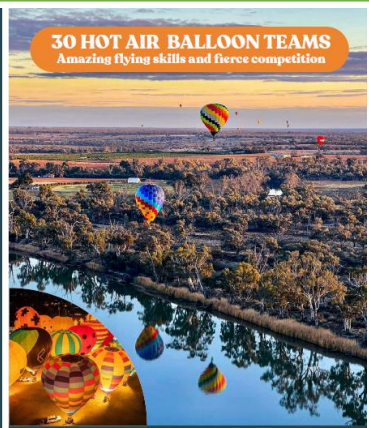
PARKING
