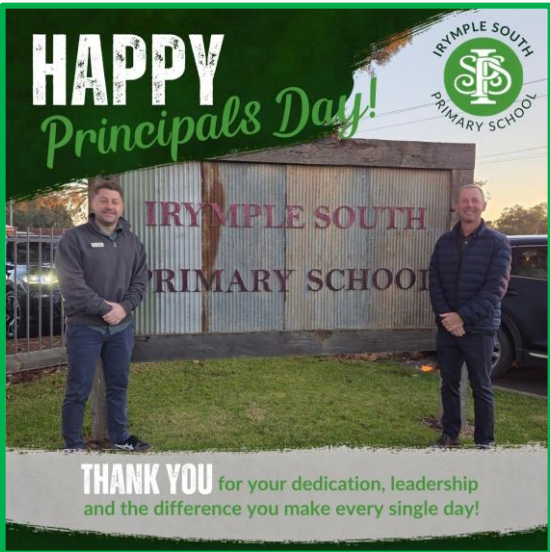




RESCHEDULED LEARNING CONFERENCES

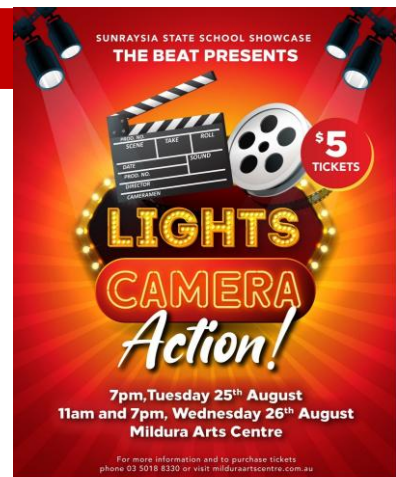
